Notice of Cancellation, Rescission, or Nonrenewal

Health Net of California, Inc. (Health Net) Commercial Group Plans

Dear «ADDR_LINE_1»,

Please read all of this notice. It contains important information about your company's Health Net group health plan coverage. An email about this information was also sent to your company, if an email address was on file.

After careful consideration, Health Net has decided to discontinue offering commercial group health plans in California.

This includes the closure of all California Small Business and Large Group Medical Plans.

Health Net is making this change to focus on government-sponsored healthcare.

What this means for your group

The last day for your Health Net group coverage will be February 28, 2027. We are providing this notice in accordance with applicable regulation(s) at least 180 days in advance of the plan closures.

Eligible employees may continue to enroll in your current Health Net coverage through February 28, 2027.

What you need to do next

- Please begin planning now so your employees do not have a gap in coverage.
 - Contact your broker to review replacement coverage options.
 - Confirm your renewal timing and transition steps.
- **You are required to promptly notify your employees about the termination of their Health Net group coverage.**
 - We have enclosed an employee letter template. You can use this letter, or you can create your own, provided that your notice is accompanied by the enclosed “Right to Submit Grievance” and “Your Health Insurance Choices Are Different”.
 - Proof of employee notification will be needed.

Transition of Care

Employees who are currently undergoing an active course of treatment should discuss transition-of-care options with their new health plan upon enrollment. Employees’ new carriers may offer transition-of-care accommodations for ongoing treatment. We encourage your employees to coordinate with their new health plan to minimize any disruption in care.

Special Enrollment Period for employees

Impacted employees may qualify for a 60-day Special Enrollment Period (SEP) due to loss of coverage. The SEP will end 60 days after the employee’s last date of coverage. If the SEP applies and they do not enroll in a new plan by that date, they will have to wait until the next open enrollment period to get health coverage. This is unless they have a life event that qualifies them for an SEP.

They will remain your primary point of contact and can coordinate directly with Health Net Account Management on your behalf, as needed.

Health Net is discontinuing offering commercial group health plans in California.

This includes the closure of your medical plan through our company.

What this means for you

The last day for your Health Net group coverage will be February 28, 2027.

Please note there is **nothing you need to do now**. Your current health coverage **will continue through February 28, 2027**.

We are reviewing your options for replacement coverage. We will notify you with details once that is in place. If you have any questions, you can call [insert your contact name and number].

Special Enrollment Period (SEP)

You may qualify for a 60-day Special Enrollment Period (SEP) in a new health plan due to loss of coverage. The SEP will end 60 days after your last day of coverage. If the SEP applies to you, and you do not enroll in a new plan by that date, you will have to wait until the next open enrollment period to get health coverage. This is unless you have a life event that qualifies them for an SEP.

Notice of Eligibility for Reduced or No-Cost Coverage

You may be eligible for reduced-cost coverage through the California Health Benefit Exchange, Covered CA, or no-cost coverage through Medi-Cal. See enclosed insert titled, “Your Health Insurance Choices Are Different”.

If you are eligible for the Medicare Program please examine their options carefully, as delaying Medicare enrollment may result in substantial financial implications.
